ORDER

THIS MATTER CAME BEFORE THE COURT for a hearing on October 22, 2009, on defendant's Motion for a New Trial/Clarification, plaintiff's Motion for Contempt, and plaintiff's Motion to Modify the Court's September 22, 2009 Protective Order.

Present:

Eugene R. Groves and Lloyd J. Lunceford for Carrollton Presbyterian Church;

John Dunlap, Russell Foster and E. Wade Shows for the Presbytery of South Louisiana.

Considering the motions, memoranda and argument of counsel;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Presbytery of South Louisiana's Motion for a New Trial/Clarification is denied;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff's Motion for Contempt is granted. Defendant is ordered to pay to Carrollton all costs, fees and expenses reasonably incurred in connection with plaintiff's Motion for Contempt (but not for any other motion heard on October 22, 2009);

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presbytery of South Louisiana shall produce the 441 documents, with attachments, listed in the Privilege Log submitted by the Presbytery of South Louisiana by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 26, 2009.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the plaintiff's Motion to Modify the Court's September 22, 2009 Protective Order is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court's September 22, 2009, Protective Order will continue to apply to the common interest documents previously produced by the Presbytery of South Louisiana and that said Protective Order shall apply equally to all documents, with attachments, listed on the Privilege Log submitted by the Presbytery of South Louisiana which

are produced. Nothing in this Order shall preclude the Court from entertaining another motion to modify the Protective Order at a later time.

FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THIS ORDER shall be deemed to be contempt of court and shall subject the party in violation to the imposition of penalties by this Court.




