TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

This action having come before the Court for consideration of "Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order" and the Court having fully considered the motion and finding good cause shown, it is hereby

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that a Temporary Restraining Order be entered against Defendant, restraining Defendant and its agents, servants, and employees, and all persons acting by, through, under, in concert with, or for it, from


(a) filing any documents in the mortgage and conveyance records of Henry County, in the state of Georgia, the effect of which would be to place a cloud on the title of any property titled in the name of Plaintiff, or otherwise taking any action to claim ownership or control of local church property whether corporeal or incorporeal, movable or immovable, or real or personal, or a right to determine ownership or control of local church property, in the possession of, control of, or owned by Timberridge;

(b) asserting any rights to the property of Timberridge Presbyterian Church or Timberridge Presbyterian Church, Inc. for so long as this Temporary Restraining Order is valid including, but not limited to, any attempt to change the locks of Timberridge; and


(c) proceeding in any way in violation of Georgia law and Plaintiff's property rights.

It is further **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that no security bond shall be required of Plaintiff as a condition to the entry of this injunction.

It is lastly **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Defendant's motion for injunctive relief be denied.

This Temporary Restraining Order shall become effective nunc pro tunc to 12:30 p.m. on October 3, 2007, and shall remain effective for a period of thirty days from the ~~effective date.~~
