Agreement in Principle for Dismissal

of First Presbyterian Church of Ingram, Texas

to the Evangelical Presbyterian Church

This Dismissal Agreement is made between the First Presbyterian Church of Ingram, Texas (Church) and Mission Presbytery (Presbytery).

The Church agrees to a one time payment to Mission Presbytery of \$120,000.

- 2. Presbytery agrees to dismiss the FPC Ingram to the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC) at the time it receives the Payment from the Church.
- 3. The Church will retain title to all of its property land, buildings, building contents, bank accounts, and any other property. Presbytery will sign the necessary documents so the Church has good title to the Church property.
- 4. The Church will retain the originals of its membership rolls and minutes and will provide copies of those documents to Presbytery.
- 5. Mission Presbytery will transfer Rev. Tear to the EPC in good standing.
- 6. This agreement will be final and binding on Presbytery and the Presbyterian Church (USA) when signed by the Presbytery Trustee(s); there will not be an appeal.
- 7. This agreement will be binding on FPC Ingram when it is approved by the congregation.
